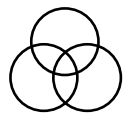


# Alfried Krupp Pupils Scholarship for practical business training in foreign countries

Based on its programme “Alfried Krupp scholarships granted to pupils taking part in the On the Job Training in Foreign Companies”, the Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Foundation has decided to award 50 new scholarships each year to pupils in Essen. The project is planned and organised by the Essen Economic Development Corporation.

This programme was established for the first time in 1998 by the Alfried Krupp von Bohlen und Halbach Foundation. Since the beginning, a total of 890 pupils have successfully completed this programme.

On this basis, 50 pupils from schools in Essen have the opportunity to get to know the requirements for their future profession and to be prepared for their career.

### Practical training objectives

- Confrontation with company structures and operations existing in the context of the related language and culture.
- Preparation of a report on the experiences made in the training period.
- Enlargement of the sensitivity of the pupils with regards to economics.
- Further enlargement in the competence of a foreign language.
- Improvement of school training orientated toward the job market.

### The Scholarship for the pupils

- Competition for all 9th, 11th and 12th grades of all secondary schools in Essen
- Two-day English language crash course prior to departure given by a native speaker
- Course "Business behaviour"
- Visit of the Folkwang Museum in Essen
- Four-weeks practical training in a company located abroad during the Easter holidays
- Welcome held at the Villa Hügel for the scholarship holders
- Two-day application training given by a personal coach

## Project Financing

The company will receive 1.400 Euro for each pupil. This money should be spent by the company for the following:

- **Accommodation:** In a guest family – older pupils at the age of 18 could also be accommodated in a Guesthouse or Hotel.
- **Catering:** Full catering must be provided everyday including public holidays and on weekends.
- **Travelling expenses:** travel expenses within the city.
- **Sightseeing and excursions:** The money should also be spent for sightseeing and excursions (entrance fees, etc).
- **Transfers:** The company is obliged to arrange the transfer of the pupil from/to the railway station/airport on the day of arrival and departure.

## Flights / Insurance

- **Flights:** are booked and paid by EWG
- **Insurances:** private liability insurance, thickness abroad and accident insurance are arranged and paid by EWG
